

# Abraham: JOURNEY OF FAITH

Week 3 | Jan. 21-25  
Two Kings | Genesis 14

Jan. 21

Read Genesis 14:1-16

After separating from Abraham and settling in Sodom, Lot is taken captive by an alliance of four kings who invade the Jordan Valley and defeat a confederation of five kings. Sodom, where Lot has chosen to live is plundered. What was Abraham's immediate response to the news of Lot's capture? (verse 14)

Jan. 22

Read Genesis 14:14-16

What was Abraham able to do that the people of verses 5-7 were unable to do? What factors were involved in Abraham's success according to verse 15 and 12:3? How would you contrast how Abraham and Lot made their decisions?

Jan. 23

Read Genesis 14:17-20

Who of the kings came to greet Abraham after his victory? Who else came and over what city does he reign? How is God described in his blessing on Abraham and how does Abraham respond?

Jan. 24

Read Genesis 14:17-20, Hebrews 7: 15-25

Abraham accepts Melchizedek's blessing and tithes ten percent to him – why? Read Hebrews 7: 15-25, how is Christ compared to this priest and king?

Jan. 25

Read Genesis 14:21-24

How did Abraham show wisdom when dealing with the king of Sodom? How does your faith in God's provision allow you to walk away from opportunities that come with strings attached? When have you refused a gift or reward because of your relationship with God?
